① The winner of the first handicap prize, Morris, had written to say that he had omitted to inform the club of an improvement of his "50" time made at the Cheshire Road Club "50" ~~some~~¹⁰ days beforehand. As it was ^{not} known at the time whether these suggestions contemplated the regulations of the R.T.C. it was agreed to continue the discussions at a later date.
