(5) Non-advertising Regulation.—The Committee reserves the right to withhold the prize in the case of a prize winner, and refuse the entry on all future occasions, of any Competitor who allows his machine or equipment to be advertised, or who gives a testimonial of the bicycle, tyres, accessories, etc., which he is using, either on the road or track.
